

BYLAW NO. 11-2018

**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF ST. BRIEUX T Amend Bylaw 10/2008
To regulate and Control Lagoon Usage by Nontax payers and
Commercial Haulers**

The Council of the Town of St. Brieux, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

THAT Bylaw 11-2018 amends bylaw 10-2008 in the following way:

REPLACE

1. "THAT a usage fee be charged in the amount of \$1,000 annually to any non-ratepayer or commercial hauler physically releasing waste into the lagoon facility to help cover costs associated with effluent disposal;"
2. THAT a stamped key will be provided once:
 - a. the fee as set out in part 1 is received for the period of January to December in any year; AND
 - b. once quarterly data is submitted in FORM A, if applicable.

WITH

1. THAT a usage fee be charged to any non-ratepayer or commercial hauler physically releasing waste into the lagoon facility to help cover costs associated with effluent disposal, based on the following rates:
See Schedule B.
2. THAT a stamped key will be provided as long as:
 - c. An agreement is signed between The Town of St Brieux and the Septic Hauler; AND
 - d. quarterly data is submitted in FORM A, if applicable. See Schedule C

THIS Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of final passing by Council.

SCHEDULE "A"

WASTE MATERIAL:

Waste Material is defined according to this Agreement to mean the remains and by-product of materials consumed or employed in connection with the home, household or family affairs and includes spoiled food, untreated sewage, swill and other organic matter. Industrial Wastes are expressly prohibited. For the purpose of this Agreement, Industrial Waste means waste that results from industrial processes or manufacturing operations. In the event that Industrial Wastes are delivered to the Disposal Facility by the Customer, the Customer agrees to accept full responsibility for any cost or liability arising once the shipment is accepted by the Disposer, so long as the Disposer did not knowingly accept wastes prohibited by this Agreement.

1500 gallon load or less	- \$50.00
1501-2000 gallons load	- \$65.00
Over 2000 gallons	- to be negotiated..
