

2017 Dust Control Application

DEADLINE MAY 05, 2017

The purpose of the Calcium Dust Control Program is to help reduce the impact of dust on residential properties adjacent to municipal roads.

Residents who wish to apply for dust control must have their application in by MAY 05, 2017. Residents are responsible for measuring the distance where the dust control is to be applied and have orange flagged stakes at either end of the application area.

Interest will be applied after 30 days at 1% per month and any unpaid bills will be added to and form part of the taxes at year end.

NO applications will be accepted after May 10, 2017.



Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Why does the grader operator sometimes grade through the dust control?

A. Occasionally, the grader operator must re-grade the applied road section to maintain a safe road surface for the public.

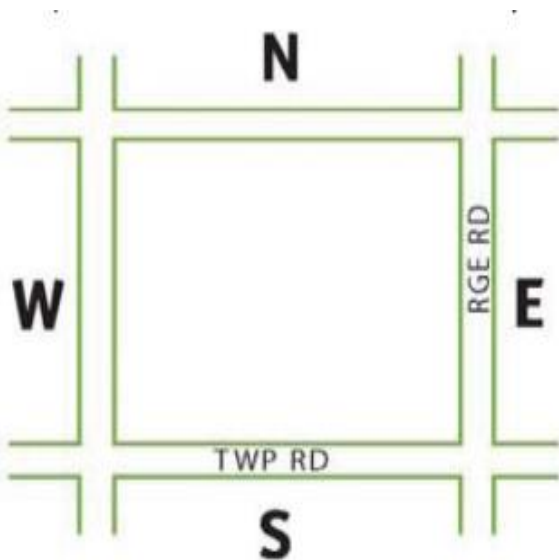
Q. What does calcium do?

A. Calcium controls the dust; but does not eliminate dust.

A maximum of 800 ft of dust control per resident will be supplied at the rate of \$4.97 per metre by 24ft width. There is no guarantee to the length of life of the calcium treatment. The Rural municipality reserves the right to maintain the public road in a safe and reliable condition even if it means the removal and/or destruction of the dust control agent.



Please mark the diagram of the section of land below to indicate the distance on either side of your approach. The applicant is responsible to stake the dust control area or the dust control will be placed an equal distance on either side of the driveway.
